The common agricultural policy (CAP), is a policy for all the citizens of the EU and the benefits that it provides to them must be clearly demonstrated.</p> <p>The focus should be on addressing misperceptions and disinformation about European agriculture and the CAP using facts and backed up with data with a view to raising public awareness on the relevance of EU support to agriculture and rural development through the CAP.</p> <p>Themes</p> <p>The proposals for information measures shall illustrate how the CAP should continue contributing towards the delivery of the Commission's political priorities.</p> <p>The Common Agricultural Policy is one of the EU's most important policies.
