Kratek opis predmeta razpisa:	<p>The objective of this call for proposals is to support EU stakeholders (single or multistakeholders) in taking actions to address consumer food waste (both in- and outof-home), covering types of actions such as behavioural change interventions, education and training, the elaboration and implementation of food waste prevention guidelines, food waste monitoring programs, awareness raising campaigns and communication materials, and development of new business models. Actions out-ofhome could, for example, take place in schools, canteens, restaurants and cafeterias.</p> <p>Proposals shall describe how the Target-Measure-Act approach²⁵ is applied in the 4 steps below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - carrying out an initial food waste diagnosis to understand the extent of the issue and to identify the “hotspots” needing specific action (e.g., target audiences, situations where food waste arises). The results of the evaluation should be publicly available and accessible for key stakeholders (see Expected impacts section for further information).
